

## THE ORGAN OF ST. MARYS UNITED CHURCH

The pipe organ is a splendid three-manual Casavant Frères instrument, Opus 281, installed in 1907. It has been upgraded many times over the years, including new pipe work and new a console in 1979 and a solid state computer control system about 10 years ago. In 2011, thousands of additional voices and sounds were added by the installation of the Rodgers MX-200 MIDI sound expansion module, giving the organist access to several different 32' pedal stops, amongst other voices.
